- ★ I have attached my classroom Syllabus HERE and will go into greater detail at back to school night(see calendar above)


★ 8/9-8/13:

WELCOME TO THE ADVENTURERS' TEAM!

I teach 2 sections of math, Math 7 and Accelerated Math 7. Math 7 is an on grade level math class while the Accelerated Math 7 is an advanced math class that encompasses all of the 7 grade math standards and most of the 8th-grade math standards. Students in the Accelerated Math class must maintain a "B" average all school year in order to stay in the advanced track. Provided students demonstrate proficiency in Accelerated Math 7, they will then take Algebra I in 8th grade. Here is a copy of the syllabus for <u>Math 7</u> and for <u>Accelerated Math 7</u>. I will be providing all students with a printed copy of the syllabus the first week of school and will ask that you sign this copy and have your student return it to me.

We will spend the first week getting to know each other as well as some placement verification to ensure that students are in the appropriate math class. Please reach out if you feel your student has been placed into the wrong math level. I am so excited to get to know and work with all of our students this year. I have been teaching middle school math for a number of years and look forward to sharing my love of math with your adolescent.

-Science

Welcome to Adventurer Science! Some of your children had me last year on the Blazer team. I've taught 7th grade science at RHMS in years past as well.

We will start the year with the question <u>"Are We Doing Science?"</u> which might seem silly, because yes......of course we are doing science in science class! Students will practice skills all scientists use such as observation, reasoning, analyzing data, etc. as they use clues (evidence) to solve mysteries.

Students will revisit their yearly LAB SAFETY rules . The main one is "No Horseplay!" There will be a **quiz on the rules** that we go over in class.



Next week we will conduct our first lab. This year the focus is on analyzing and interpreting data. This is one of the 8 Science and Engineering Practices (SEP) suggested by the NSTA and used with the NGSS. **For all you science nerds you can learn more about the SEP <u>here</u>.

Looking forward to another great year being curious and asking questions about how the world (and universe) works!

Social Studies
