Math 7:

Students will be continuing to learn about solving equations. Students will be incorporating the distributive property and combining like terms in their solving of equations. We will review and have a test on solving equations on Wednesday.

Accelerated Math 7:

This week we will be exploring linear equations. We will be wrapping up this unit with graphing in slope intercept and standard form. Students will have an end of unit test on Linear Equations on Friday.





Biq Idea: What happens when objects collide?

Students had their final quiz for this quarter last week. It wrapped up our unit on predicting natural hazards.



This week we begin our final unit for the year.....PHYSICS!!! We will begin by exploring what forces are and how they interact to dictate motion of objects. We will be looking at how we can predict motion using the laws of physics. We should be able to do many hands-on labs with this unit and also have some competitions!

Social Studies

Students will continue to explore the three major Abrahmic religions and how they are related to the story of the Holocaust. We will begin looking at examples of anti-semitism throughout history and explore if it is a new or old idea.

After Spring Break we will begin to explore the Holocaust aand the direct consquences of it. We will look at the Israeli/Palestinian conflict as a more current event.

I have spoken with the kids about being respectful about different religions and why making Holocaust jokes is incredibly inappropriate. In early April, the 7th grade teams was lucky enough to secure a virtual holocaust speaker. More details to come as the date approaches.
