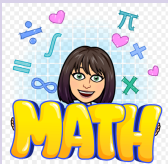

Accelerated Math 7:

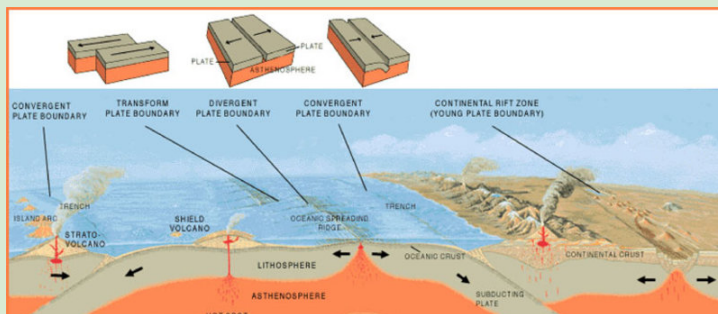

Big Idea: How is the Earth's surface in constant motion?

We continue to explore the ways Earth's surface is in constant motion. This week we will focus on plate boundaries and what happens when they interact.

Sometimes the motion is slow (continental drift) and sometimes it's very fast (earthquakes and volcanoes).

Social Studies

This week in Social Studies we will be closely looking at how geography impacted Rome. Students will be learning how the geography surrounding the City of Rome gave it a lot of advantages to allow it to become one of the most powerful empires in history.

On Friday, we will be having a map quiz. Students should have their maps completed in order to do well on this quiz. During block day I will give out a practice quiz with similar questions so they are aware of what the quiz will be like.
