<u>Final Exam</u> (May 18 - 20) - To prepare for the final exam, all math classes will spend part of team time each week reviewing concepts from the school year. Each student was given a review packet. This review packet is due either Wednesday or Thursday depending on when your student has math class.

Big Idea: What underlying forces explain the variety of interactions observed in the world (Universe)?

Students conducted a few labs last week looking at the effects of magnetic fields on objects (iron filings and paper clips). We are able to map the force fields even though we can't see the force itself.

This week we will have a QUIZ FRIDAY MAY 20th on "Forces acting at a distance" (Gravity and Magnetism). We will review in class and conduct one final lab.
